## A HELPFUL TIP!

We want to wish everyone a safe and Happy Holiday Season this year. Here are a few good tips to remember as we prepare for winter and the holiday season:

- Be careful with holiday decorations. Choose decorations that are flam resistant or flame retardant
- Keep lit candles away from decorations and other things that can burn.
- Replace any string of lights with worn or broken cords or lose bulb connections. Connect no more than 3 strands of mini-light sets and a maximum of 50 bulbs for screw-in bulbs.
- Use clips, not nails, to hang lights so the cords do not get damaged.

#### Also remember to:

- Test your smoke alarms and tell guests about your home fire escape plan.
- Keep children and pets away from lit candles.
- Keep matches and lighters up high in a locked cabinet.
- Ask smokers to smoke outside. Remind smokers to keep their smoking materials with them so young children do not touch them.
- Provide large, deep ashtrays for smokers. Wet cigarette butts with water before discarding.
